'THE SHOW MUST GO ON'

From Tiller Girl to Hotel Owner!

Avril has recently completed 40 years running the Cloud Hotel in Brockenhurst – a most appropriate speaker for our Anniversary.

But before that, she was a member of the celebrated Tiller Girls Dancing Troupe.

Avril founded the Wessex Women's Network in 2003, published her first book in 2007, and in 2008 she was awarded the MBE for her work for charities and in the hospitality sector.

It's quite a story! From humble beginnings.....

The inaugural meeting of the Club took place on 18th April 1977 with just a small membership, and during that first year four of the speakers were from within the Club. However, as the membership grew, outside speakers were gradually brought in.

The first social events? An outing to Exbury Gardens, a visit to the Playhouse Theatre in Salisbury, and a skittles evening!

However things did not run entirely smoothly during that first year. In July two members of the committee promptly resigned, although the reasons for this are not recorded. And then sadly, the Vice President suddenly passed away. But replacements to the committee were co-opted, and the Club moved on.

Finally, in December, the members were delighted to receive the gift of a Gavel and Block (from a Mr. and Mrs. Collins) which is still in use today.

So, some 40 years later we are still going strong (membership currently 48) with the organisation of the Club having remained largely unchanged throughout that time.
